

Description:

The purpose of this roadway project is the milling and resurfacing as well as reconstruction of the 3.31 miles of roadway pavement on NW 8th Avenue between NW 6th Street and NW 40th Drive, just east of 43rd Street.

- Segment A (NW 40th Dr to NW 34th St)
- Segment B (NW 34th St to NW 23rd St)
- Segment C (NW 23rd St to NW 6th St)

During the design phase, alternatives to roadway traffic configurations were developed as requested by citizen input and the City Commission. Alternatives include lane reduction from 4-lanes to 2-lanes with the inclusion of bike lanes in Segment B and bike lanes and on-street parking in Segment C. See diagrams and pictures on the following pages of this report.

Current Status: The City Commission has approved plans for Segments A and C. They have authorized a study of a 2-lane alternative for Segment B. The study is underway from August 4th through the first week of December.

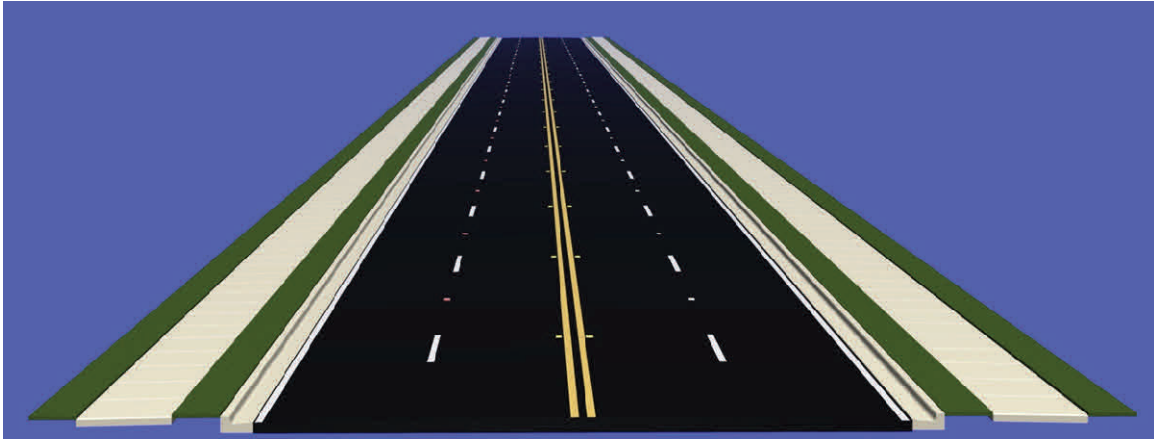
